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
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


SOD-123 CASE 425 STYLE 1



Figure 1. Recovery Time Equivalent Test Circuit

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



Figure 2. Forward Voltage



V<sub>R</sub>, REVERSE VOLTAGE (VOLTS)






Figure 4. Capacitance


